**IN THE MATTER OF:
MOTIONS TO MODIFY DOMESTIC TEMPORARY ACTIONS**

ORDER

Due to the increasing number of domestic cases filed in Cherokee County, the Court will no longer consider motions for modification of a domestic temporary order until the following procedures have been completed: The moving party shall:

1. file a certificate of completion of discovery (with a copy to opposing counsel). Opposing counsel shall be afforded five (5) days to file a traverse to the certificate of discovery. Upon failure on the part of opposing counsel to file the traverse, the motion to modify may be filed.
2. file a Domestic Relations Pre-Trial Order (available from the judge's office).
3. complete the Seminar for Divorcing Parents (where appropriate).
4. complete mediation (where appropriate).
